The Young Professionals Committee was born from the desire of young professionals to give back and make a difference in the fight against cancer. Committee members serve as ambassadors for Gabrielle's Angel Foundation through fundraising, promotion, networking, and general advocacy for our mission. The annual YPC Gala brings together supporters across many different industries for a night of music, cocktails, and dancing. All proceeds from the YPC Gala support the Foundation's music therapy and research programs.

Gabrielle's Angel Foundation for Cancer Research was created in memory of Gabrielle Rich Aouad who died of leukemia in 1996 at the age of 27. It was her wish and vision that a foundation be created to fund research so that others would not suffer as she did. Gabrielle's Angel Foundation funds the best and brightest young scientists who are searching for better treatments, preventions and cures for leukemia, lymphoma and other blood cancers. The Foundation also funds music therapy programs at select hospitals. Gabrielle believed that “music heals the soul” and the music therapy program was created to honor her love of music and helping others.

The Night

The inaugural YPC event was held at the Fleur Room, New York in the summer of 2019. Since our first gala, each event hosted by the YPC has sold out weeks in advance. The YPC Gala is quickly becoming one of the most anticipated charity events in NYC, raising crucial funds for cancer research and music therapy. Past events have honored longtime Foundation supporters Andrew Warren, Serena Kerrigan, Ubah Hassan, Kyle Lutnick, Andrea DiNunzio, and Charlie Walk. Since 2019, our events have raised **nearly \$1M for our mission.**



The Gala








Gabrielle's Angel Foundation Raises Over \$93,000
